- Raise awareness and understanding of the issues relating to teenage pregnancy and abortion so that practitioners are able to provide education and support that meets young people's needs
- Enable practitioners to facilitate constructive discussion of pregnancy options with their clients and to support them in informed decision-making and contraceptive planning
- Explore the causes of repeat conceptions and identify effective practice to help reduce its incidence

Who Should Attend:-

Anyone working (Paid or Voluntary) with young people in Brent, especially Teachers; Youth Workers; Social Care Staff; School Nurses; Health Visitors and other Health Professionals; etc

By the end of the course participants will be able to:

- Explain the importance of addressing unintended pregnancy and abortion with young people and professionals
- Summarise key policies relating to young people, abortion, confidentiality and the law
- Reflect on how their own and others' views on pregnancy and abortion can influence their work with young people
- Identify a range of practical strategies to help support pregnant clients to make their own, informed decisions about pregnancy
- Discuss abortion provision and explain how abortion relates to physical and emotional health
- Identify some of the causes of repeat unintended pregnancy
- Discuss effective practice to help young people reduce risks and implement and maintain contraceptive plans
- Plan the actions needed to implement learning in the workplace
