‘Spiralling’ is a CD Rom resource for use in schools and other youth settings to promote gender equality, healthy relationships and to help prevent domestic violence in the future lives of children and young people. It includes activities for use with all children and young people aged 5 and above.

Aim & Learning Objectives:-

The ‘Spiralling’ toolkit and film will be used throughout the course as the training medium for most of the aims below; day two of the training will give participants opportunities to practice leading some of the activities themselves.

1. To give all participants a thorough knowledge of what domestic abuse is, what allows it to happen and how we might be able to prevent it through work with children and young people in schools and other youth settings;
2. To equip participants with the knowledge and skills to run awareness training courses for all school or youth work staff on domestic violence, the effects on children, ways that schools and other youth settings can help children experiencing domestic violence now and an overview of ways that they can help to prevent domestic violence in the future;
3. To give participants an introduction to and practice at using the core elements of the Spiralling toolkit including the film, drama games and activities, and the discussion activities;
4. To equip the participants to run training sessions for teachers and support staff in order that they can use the activities with their pupils;
5. Depending on the skills and experience of the participants, to equip them to run some of the activities in schools and other youth settings, with teacher support, directly with children and young people.

Who Should Attend:-

Anyone working (Paid or Voluntary) with young people in Brent, especially Teachers (both Primary and Secondary); Youth Workers, Health Professionals, those working in Faith, Community, Social Care; Criminal Justice, Community Safety, settings, etc
